KEYNOTE SPEAKER

DR. SARAH ENGLAND, PHD

SARAH K. ENGLAND, PH.D IS THE ALAN A. AND EDITH L. WOLFF PROFESSOR OF MEDICINE AND PROFESSOR OF **OBSTETRICS AND GYNECOLOGY AT** WASHINGTON UNIVERSITY. SHE JOINED THE FACULTY AT WASHINGTON UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF MEDICINE IN JULY 2011 AND HAS A SECONDARY APPOINTMENT IN THE DEPARTMENT OF CELL BIOLOGY AND PHYSIOLOGY WHERE HER LABORATORY HAS THREE MAIN LINES OF INVESTIGATION: ONE FOCUS IS TO DETERMINE HOW ION CHANNELS IN THE MYOMETRIUM MODULATE UTERINE **EXCITABILITY AND CONTRACTILITY** DURING PREGNANCY. SECOND, THEY ARE INVESTIGATING THE ROLE AND **REGULATION OF THE OXYTOCIN RECEPTOR IN CONTROLLING UTERINE** EXCITABILITY. LASTLY, THEY ARE STUDYING HOW DISRUPTIONS IN ENDOGENOUS CIRCADIAN RHYTHMS AFFECT PREGNANCY OUTCOMES.
