A condition for using MCW Cancer Center supported Shared Resources is that each Shared Resource is acknowledged in the publication. The Cancer Center has invested heavily in Shared Resource expertise, instrumentation, and administration and it is therefore imperative that, whenever possible, Shared Resource activity be acknowledged publications as well as posters and presentations even if the work of the Shared Resource has been fully funded by a PI (for instance, through existing grants). The acknowledgments enable the Cancer Center to measure and document Shared Resource productivity, impact, and service to members.

- Standard fee-for-service analysis
- Minor material support, e.g., cells, antibodies, DNA
- Boilerplate Methods write-up
