APG-20 Metreleptin

Purpose: This study is being done to see whether a medication called metreleptin, also known as the study medication/treatment, is safe and works in patients with familial partial lipodystrophy (FPLD).

What Is Involved: If you decide you would like to participate in the study, you can expect to be in the study for a minimum of 16.5 months. There are 11 in-person visits and 1 phone call

Exclusion Criteria: Previous treatment with Metreleptin, Leptin greater than 20, APL, and more....
