Since 2019, when the declaration was made, more than 200 other jurisdictions have followed suit.</p> <p>There are significant health disparities for Milwaukee County residents as a result of racism, which impacts community health overall. In fact, Milwaukee County is currently ranked 70 out of 72 counties for health in the state of Wisconsin, while surrounding counties rank highest for health in the state.</p> <p>The keynote address will share information about what it takes to move systems forward toward a future that leverages political reform, policy initiatives, partnerships, community-centric strategy, and technology to achieve racial and health equity.</p>
