 - If the article is not published but has been accepted by the journal, provide evidence of the acceptance, such as a copy of the official acceptance email from the editor.
- A nomination letter commenting on your contribution to, and the significance of, this paper. This letter may be written by a mentor (PI or otherwise) or by the submitting postdoc. Preference will be given to applications providing a confidential nomination letter from a mentor who is also an author on the publication. Please have this sent separately to postdoc@mcw.edu.
- Submit your completed application to postdoc@mcw.edu by **August 15, 2024, at 5:00 PM**. **All materials must be received by this time.** **By submitting this application, all applicants agree that, if awarded, you will be expected to give one of two keynote lectures on your manuscript at the upcoming MCW Postdoc Research Symposium during National Postdoc Appreciation Week in September of 2024.*
